# Overview of Today's Readings for Your Personal Walk of Faith

In Holy Baptism, the Triune God Reveals Himself and Recreates Us in His Image – "In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth" (Gen. 1:1). Then, as "the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters" (Gen. 1:2), God spoke His Word: "'Let there be light,' and there was light" (Gen. 1:3). In the same way, "the beginning of the gospel of Jesus Christ" (Mark 1:1) brings about the new creation through the waters of Baptism by the same Word and Spirit of God. When John the Baptist came, "proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins," Jesus also came "and was baptized by John in the Jordan" (Mark 1:4, 9). Although He had no sins of His own, He took His stand with sinners in His Baptism and took the sins and mortality of the world upon Himself. He was baptized into His own death, by which the heavens are opened and the Spirit is given to us. God the Father is well pleased with His beloved Son and raises Him from the dead. As we share His Baptism and are "united with him in a death like his" (Rom. 6:5), we also share His resurrection unto "newness of life" (Rom. 6:4).

January in Hope Preschool/4K – The 3K students will learn about Arctic Animals, our five senses and germs and staying healthy. Also, we enjoy being at school with our preschool friends and learning every day. During Jesus time we are learning about Jesus Baptism, Jesus Heals and Jesus feeds 5000. The 4K students will focus on seasons, dinosaurs and dental health. In math we will talk about mittens and polar animals using comparing, sorting, patterning and problem solving. All 4K students will be tested on mid-year benchmarks (letters and numbers). Jesus time in 4K is optional and is from 11:00-11:15. We will learn about Jesus as a young boy and his baptism.
