

Preschool Tuition



Tuition and Other Fees

Living Savior Preschool is a **not-for-profit organization**, and we try hard to keep our tuition as affordable as possible. Our school is supported entirely by tuition and fees, supplemented by donations and annual fundraisers.

Tuition is considered an annual amount and may be paid in advance; however, we have broken it down into monthly increments for families' convenience:

- Registration Fee [nonrefundable] \$ 75.00
- Monthly tuition for 3-year-olds \$155.00
- Monthly tuition for 4-year-olds \$180.00
- Materials/ Activities fee \$50.00
- Pre-K registration (nonrefundable) \$200.00
- Pre-k Monthly Tuition \$350.00

For Preschool only, we require payment of first and last months' tuition (September and May) & Materials/activities fee by August 1st.

A sibling tuition discount of 25 percent is offered for additional children (after the first one) from the same family.



Preschool Curriculum

Our **lead teacher, Michelle Wolfe**, is in charge of curriculum. She has a Masters Degree in Reading and Literacy. Michelle and the other teachers work together to develop activities centered on Concordia Publishing House's "One In Christ" Bible-based curriculum. Dramatic play will focus on life experiences or on community helpers (such as an office, restaurant, grocery store, hospital or fire station). The children use all of their senses to explore. Cognitive skills are encouraged with a variety of games, puzzles, and other materials. Large motor skills are strengthened through the use of a parachute, bean bags, games, and balls. Outdoor and indoor playground equipment provide an opportunity to stretch and exercise. A wide variety of creative media allow the artist in your child to express himself or herself (we do an art project every day).

We help **prepare your child for kindergarten** by teaching the alphabet, colors, numbers, patterns, songs, and even a little Spanish! **Academics** are taught *through play*, such as matching games and finger plays. We have incorporated "Handwriting Without Tears" into our fours program to help them with their writing skills. Our other focus is on **socialization**: our preschool program sends your child to kindergarten **ready to learn** – children who can sit in a group and listen, line up and make a transition from one place to another, interact with other children in appropriate ways, wash hands before eating and after using the bathroom, wait for his or her turn to talk or play with a toy, and other life skills.

ENROLLMENT

Children who are 3 or 4 years old by **September 1st** may enroll in a 3- or 4-year old class, respectively, for that school year.

3-year-old classes:

Maximum 15 students

With one teacher & one assistant teacher

Meets Tuesday & Thursday

Two classes from 9:00 to 11:30am;

One class from 12:45 to 3:15pm

4-year-old classes:

Maximum 17 students

With one teacher & one assistant teacher

Meets Monday, Wednesday, & Friday

Two classes from 9:00 to 11:30am;

One class from 12:45 to 3:15pm

Pre-K Program

Our Pre-K class is designed for the older preschooler who will be turning five years old by or before December 31, 2018 and who is developmentally ready to experience more structure and academics than our four's preschool program. Also Pre-K is intended to serve five-year-olds who are not quite ready for full-day kindergarten but are in need of more structure, with a focus on academics, in preparation for elementary school.

Katie Gates is our lead teacher; she has a BA Degree in Psychology. Our Pre-K program fosters development in core areas of literacy and math driven by kindergarten Common Core State Standards. We are a God-centered, nurturing, organized environment. Our curriculum is developmentally appropriate, integrated, and hands-on. Our thematic units encompass reading, math, science, music, and art. With a small class size of 16, we are able to meet individualized needs.
