The Catechism Daily Prayers

AS THE HEAD OF THE FAMILY SHOULD TEACH IT IN A SIMPLE WAY TO HIS HOUSEHOLD

- P In the morning when you get up, make the sign of the holy cross and say:
- C In the name of the Father and of the + Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.
- P Then, kneeling or standing, repeat the Creed and the Lord's Prayer. If you choose, you may also say this little prayer:
- C I thank You, my heavenly Father, through Jesus Christ, Your dear Son, that You have kept me this night from all harm and danger; and I pray that You would keep me this day also from sin and every evil, that all my doings and life may please You. For into Your hands I commend myself, my body and soul, and all things. Let Your holy angel be with me, that the evil foe may have no power over me. Amen.
- P Then go joyfully to your work, singing a hymn, like that of the Ten Commandments, or whatever your devotion may suggest.

Welcome to Worship! Isaiah "saw the Lord sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up." He was overcome with an awareness of his sin and "unclean lips," but the Lord atoned for his sin, took away his guilt and sanctified his lips with a burning coal from the altar. After being forgiven, he was called and sent as a prophet of the Lord's Word. In the same way, when Simon Peter and his companions "enclosed a large number of fish," he, too, was overcome with an awareness of his sin and said, "Depart from me, for I am a sinful man." Jesus, however, comforted Simon, called him to discipleship, and declared that he would be "catching men." Like that boat in the Gospel where Jesus taught, the Church remains the place today where Jesus still teaches His people. The preaching of Christ Jesus is still a manifestation of the Holy Spirit, where the epistle says He continues to build up His Church on earth.
