The Prayer of the Week

Lord Jesus, You are the Good Shepherd, without whom nothing is secure. Rescue and preserve us that we may not be lost forever but follow You, rejoicing in the way that leads to eternal life; for You live and reign with the Father and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen

Welcome to Worship! Today's readings take us into God's very heart—His seeking and saving nature when it comes to His sinful creatures. The Introit is a hymn of praise from the Psalmist for God's seeking, finding, and delivering him from death. In the Collect, we pray that God would "Rescue and preserve us that we may not be lost forever but follow You...." The Old Testament reading is a castigation of the under shepherds of Israel who failed to guide and took advantage of the sheep. God promises to come personally and gather His sheep. In the Gospel, Jesus demonstrates God's seeking and saving nature by eating with tax collectors and sinners and calling them into His kingdom, and telling them parables about how God seeks after the lost. The Epistle is a prayer of thanks from Paul that God has made him an under shepherd in the church.
