BUY A BOARD FOR TODDLERS AND TEENS - Summer is winding down, work schedules are returning to “normal”, school begins shortly and our attention begins to be drawn to the upcoming holiday season. In the meantime, the needs of many, especially the impoverished continues. For those of you who are new to Living Savior, our congregation helps to support four ministries on the White Mountain Apache Reservation in Arizona. It has come to my attention that “Our Children’s Shelter” is in need of four more toddler beds. A few years ago a couple of men from Living Savior built four beds. According to the director of the shelter, these beds are holding up better than anything purchased from the furniture store! The Kennel, which houses Apache Youth Ministries is in need of new picnic tables. The current tables are eight to ten years old and in need of repair or replacement. These tables are used for outdoor activities from Bible Study to social gatherings.

How can we help” you might ask? I realize not everyone is a carpenter or even a “closet carpenter” and sometimes there aren’t enough hours in a day to undertake such a project. I also realize, for those interested in building a bed or a picnic table, that the cost of lumber in recent weeks has skyrocketed.
