"Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed."


John 20:29

Thomas is often looked on in a bad light. Shamefaced along with all the other disciples who forsook Jesus as He went to the cross for the sins of all humankind, he suffers the misfortune of being absent during Jesus' first two post-resurrection appearances to His disciples. Stubbornly Thomas clings to his skepticism, only to have it melt at the sound of his Master's voice, "Stop doubting and believe."

"Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed." *We* are those people. St. Peter wrote, "Though you have not seen Him, you love Him; and even though you do not see Him now, you believe in Him and are filled with an inexpressible and glorious joy" (1 Peter 1:8). To be sure, we have our "Thomas" moments when our faith wavers and we stubbornly cling to our unbelief. It is then when our Savior, who has called us by our name, assures us of His guiding presence. Redeemed by our precious Savior, whom yet unseen we love, we are assured of eternity in heaven, where we will see God face to face. Then our faith will be changed to sight and our prayer to praise. "I do believe; help me overcome my unbelief!" (Mark 9:24).

Many Signs and Wonders Done

¹² Now many signs and wonders were regularly done among the people by the hands of the apostles. And they were all together in Solomon's Portico. ¹³ None of the rest dared join them, but the people held them in high esteem. ¹⁴ And more than ever believers were added to the Lord, multitudes of both men and women, ¹⁵ so that they even carried out the sick into the streets and laid them on cots and mats, that as Peter came by at least his shadow might fall on some of them. ¹⁶ The people also gathered from the towns around Jerusalem, bringing the sick and those afflicted with unclean spirits, and they were all healed.

¹² Then I turned to see the voice that was speaking to me, and on turning I saw seven golden lampstands, ¹³ and in the midst of the lampstands one like a son of man, clothed with a long robe and with a golden sash around his chest. ¹⁴ The hairs of his head were white, like white wool, like snow. His eyes were like a flame of fire, ¹⁵ his feet were like burnished bronze, refined in a furnace, and his voice was like the roar of many waters. ¹⁶ In his right hand he held seven stars, from his mouth came a sharp two-edged sword, and his face was like the sun shining in full strength.

¹⁷ When I saw him, I fell at his feet as though dead. But he laid his right hand on me, saying, "Fear not, I am the first and the last, ¹⁸ and the living one. I died, and behold I am alive forevermore, and I have the keys of Death and Hades.
