


Alive in Christ

- a. Romans 10:9, **Because if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.** (written in _____ A.D)
- b. 1 Corinthians 12:3, **Therefore I want you to understand that no one speaking in the Spirit of God ever says “Jesus is accursed!” and no one can say “Jesus is Lord” except in the Holy Spirit.** (written in 55 A.D.)
