## THEN AND Now- many changes but our mission remains the same!

Three hundred people attended the First Biennial Convention in Fort Wayne in the summer of 1943, including 77 delegates from 19 districts. Delegates were housed in the Seminary dorms, the first time women had ever occupied those rooms. Their room rate was 75 cents per night. Flash forward to 2017. For 75 cents, you can buy two packets of Mustard Seed Devotions from the LWML Store. Three thousand four hundred people are registered for this convention, including almost 500 delegates from 40 districts. Attendees are housed in various hotels all over the city of Albuquerque with room rates around \$130/night.

# WELCOME TO THE 75<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY CONVENTION!




Welcome to convention! And welcome to Albuquerque! I am so happy that you are here to enjoy all the aspects of the convention experience — worship, Bible study, service,







## COMMUNION STONEWARE AND WINE

The Communion stoneware was designed by artisan Paula L. Dodd from Twin Falls, Idaho. Most of her artistic life was limited to stick figures until she discovered the joys of pottery about ten years ago. She teaches wheel-thrown pottery classes at the Hands On Studio in Twin Falls. Her design includes blue and purple colors on the chalice/flagon which is dipped and shaken down over the purple allowing a unique drip effect. This is custom-made Communion ware in high-fired stoneware.

Yet you, Lord, are our Father. We are the clay, you are the potter; we are all the work of your hand (Isaiah 64:8).

The Communion wine — Blue Teal Rio Rojo, from Blue Teal Vineyards and purchased through Total Wines of ABQ — was selected from a number of varieties for the 2017 Communion service. Blue Teal Vineyards was founded in 1981. Its first vineyard was planted just east of Lordsburg, New Mexico and consisted of 11 varietals. The vineyard neighbored a large pond that welcomed migratory Blue-Winged Teals during the winter, thus becoming the vineyard's mascot, and later namesake. Offering a large selection of award-winning wines, their philosophy is to let these wines express what was created in the vineyard with simple application of sun, soil, and time.
