Leader: In the name of our Triune God; Father, Son and Holy Spirit. AMEN

Read together: (Say or sing.) LSB 717 vs.1

Eternal Father, strong to save, Whose arm hath bound the restless wave, Who bidd'st the mighty ocean deep, Its own appointed limits keep: O hear us when we cry to Thee, For those in peril on the sea.

Leader: Heavenly Father, we pray for the men and women in our military who serve You as they serve our country. Help us to be of service to them by providing what they need when they return from times of deployment – which is mercy, witness, and life together. We thank You for the assistance provided by Operation Barnabas and the work they so faithfully do.

Read together: (Say or sing.) **LSB 717 vs. 2**

Leader: Lord, Jesus Christ, You are the true meaning of peace, yet we live in a world of unrest and conflict. Read together: (Say or sing.) LSB 717 vs. 3

Leader: Lord God, Holy Spirit, You have been sent to us as our Comforter. Read together: (Say or sing.) LSB 717 vs. 4
