Story

... as you did it to one of the least of these my brothers, you did it to me (Matthew 25:40).

Because the life expectancy in Haiti is so short, little preparation is made for the care of the elderly. This grant, Christian Eldercare Home in Jacmel, Haiti, provides funds to build a center for the elderly. These are people that have out-lived their families and have no place to go.

In response to the January 2010 earthquake, the Lutheran Village concept was developed in Beaudouin. This property in Jacmel is similar and is anchored by a Lutheran Church in the front, Lutheran homes in the center, and an orphanage at the rear of the property. Adding the Christian Elder Care facility, to the rest of the village, provides care for all ages.

Emmanuel Michele, a leader in the Premier Evangelical Lutheran Church of Jacmel asked, "Why are American missionaries so eager to care for our children but no one pays attention to our old people?" Thus a plan was conceived that includes a Christian home for the elderly, adjacent to The Center of Refuge Orphanage. This plan will create "grandparents" for the children and "children" for the grandparents – a joy to the elderly and children alike. The elderly will have a church much closer to them, and they can be cared for physically, emotionally, and spiritually.

LCMS World Missions no longer provides disaster support in Haiti since it is part of the Latin America Region. Both the LWML and Ministry in Mission (RSO) have taken on the challenge to provide aid in Haiti and are recruiting congregations to raise funds for houses and ministry to these people.
