Table Discussion 1:

- How do you spend time with God daily?
 - What setting works best for you? Time of day? Location without distractions? Resources?
- When did you feel especially blessed after starting your day with God? Please share as much as you are comfortable sharing with your group

Feedback 1:

1. What new ideas did you hear from your table partners?
2. Was there anything that was shared that you'd like to implement in your own devotional time?

Table Discussion 2:

Open your Bible to any passage of Scripture and read it out loud to your table group. Then together answer these questions:

- What is the context?
- What is happening here in this text?
- What does this say?
- How does this apply to me?

Feedback 2:

1. How did it feel to do this exercise in Bible study?
2. Did anything stand out for you in the process?
3. Was this a simple or difficult process to use?
4. Do you think you'd feel comfortable doing this on a daily basis?

Table Discussion 3:

Discuss how you can share God's love with those around you. Cite specific examples if you feel comfortable doing so.

Feedback 3:

1. What was one of the "best" ideas shared in your table group?
2. What was one of the "most unique" ideas shared in your table group?



Table Discussion 4:

With your table group, create a list of examples of humble service. Write them on large newsprint so they can be displayed for the whole group to see.

Table Discussion 5:

Take a few minutes quietly to reflect on the following:

- How and where is He calling you to serve?
- How can you serve Him?
- What gifts has He given you?

When your leader announces the reflection time is over, share some of your initial thoughts and ideas with the others at your table as you feel comfortable. Listen and encourage each other as you reflect on how God is working and leading in your lives.
