Mobile Medical Mercy Mission Bus for Guatemala — \$100,000

Over 50 percent of the children in Guatemala are malnourished and have no access to any form of medical or dental care. A network of LCMS partner churches and the Lutheran Church of Guatemala have partnered to share God’s physical and spiritual healing with as many souls as possible. This mission grant will be used to purchase and retrofit a bus with medical equipment. Bible school equipment will also be purchased, enabling teams to heal both the physical and spiritual needs of the Guatemalan children. While physicians tend to physical needs, ministers and lay leaders will go into villages and set up Bible classes, Vacation Bible School, and worship services.

Restoring Hope for Detroit Children and Families — \$100,000

Camp Restore Detroit provides a safe, nurturing, Christ-centered place for children and their families to come and learn about God’s love as they participate in art, theater, and music classes. They also receive assistance with homework and basic educational and developmental skills. The adults are offered parenting, finance, and resume-building classes. This mission grant will fund the renovation of previously abandoned houses into community outreach centers, along with the house furnishings and outreach materials.

God’s Grace for This Generation — \$100,000

LAMP Ministry, Inc., has been serving the nearly one million indigenous people that live in remote and unreachable villages in northern Canada. Approximately one half of this population is under the age of 14, and 15 percent of this population will take their own lives, out of despair and hopelessness. Through this mission grant, LAMP will fulfill their mission of sharing the Gospel by expanding their staff of full-time missionary pilots. They will recruit and train 100 to 200 additional volunteer missionaries committed to serve at least five years and help LAMP reach their goals.
