[Plentiful grapes, pomegranates and figs. v. 23; It was a land flowing with milk and honey v. 27] What did the majority of the spies fear about the new land? _____[That the inhabitants were too powerful for them to conquer.] What did Caleb urge the people to do? _______ [To trust God and go head and enter the land.] What did the negative spies call themselves in comparison to the giants of the land? Have you ever felt this way in the face of your problems and obstacles? _____[Grasshoppers.] WHAT DOES GOD'S WORD SAY ABOUT THESE VITAL SIGNS?
