



MIGHTY MISSION MITES

People needed for drama:

One person to hold sign, “News Flash”
Ms. World
Ms. Mite Box
Local District Reporter
Might Mission Mite
Four (4) to be coin holders

Props needed:

Sign with large letters “NEWS FLASH”
Coins – 4 – could be handmade or real
Two microphones
Large globe
Large mite box
Words to Mission Mite song

One person crosses stage holding up “News Flash” sign
Reporter stands on one side of stage with microphone
Mrs. World and Mrs. Mite box enter and stand center stage.

Reporter: (*introduces herself to the audience*) Good afternoon (evening)! I’m _____(name) _____ from the _____(name of district publication)_____. I’m here today to get the scoop on Ms. World and Ms. Mite Box (*walks over to them*). Good afternoon (evening), Ms. World! Tell me, why are you here today?

Ms. World: (*holds up globe*) I’m here to promote missions WORLD WIDE! (*turns around with globe*)

Reporter: (*turns to Ms. Mite Box*) Good afternoon (evening), Ms. Mite Box. Why are you here today?

Ms. Mite Box: (*holding up large mite box*) I’m here today to inform everyone who I am. The mite box holds collected money for missions such as _____(insert specific mission projects)_____. Our missions are worldwide and collections need to start somewhere! Many smaller versions of me are on kitchen tables ALL OVER the _____ District. That covers _____ (state)_____, and/or _____(state)_____ states. (*conversation is interrupted*)

Mighty Mission Mite: (*enters at back of audience with great enthusiasm*) HELLO! HELLO! HELLO! (*stops at several people and greets them – uses microphone*) Hello, how are you today? So nice to see you here! I’m so glad you could make it here today! (*short, quick greetings – walks to front of audience*) Hello everyone! (*cheerfully*) I’m Mighty Mission Mite. Have you been on a mission lately? I travel ALL over the world helping people everywhere! I help to spread the news that Jesus Christ is the Savior and Redeemer of the world. YOU can help, too! (*while still talking walks out to staged audience people*) I know there are people here today who are ready and willing to help me. Let me see, now just where are they? (*finds first coin person near front of audience*) There you are! What have you brought for me today?

1st Person: I brought a mite for missions today!

2nd Person: (*stand and interrupts – opposite side of aisle*) I have some mites, too!

Mighty Mission Mite: That makes me s-o-o-o happy!

3rd Person: (*stands opposite of #2*) Mighty Mission Mite, I brought you some mites today, too!

Mighty Mission Mite: *(walks to the 4th person – stands quietly)* What have you brought today?

4th Person: *(talks quietly but still can be heard)* Just a mite. It's all I have. I'm a poor widow. I saved this just for today and just for the Lord's work. I know you will put it to good use.

Mighty Mission Mite: Praise the Lord! What generous people we have here today! *(motions to the 4 people to follow to front to Ms. Mite Box – motions audience to stand and sing – tells where song is located)* Let's sing to the tune of the "Battle Hymn of the Republic:"

Going on a trip, clunk, clunk! *(1st person drops coin in large mite box)*

Going on a trip, clunk, clunk! *(2nd person drops coin in large mite box)*

We're mighty mission mites

Going on a trip, clunk, clunk! *(3rd person drops coin in large mite box)*

We're mighty mission mites! *(4th person drops coin in large mite box)*

(Everyone motioned to sit)

Mighty Mission Mite: Thank you, thank you, thank you! Praise the Lord!

Reporter: Mighty Mission Mite?

Mighty Mission Mite: *(unaware of the Reporter, looks stunned and says slowly)* Y-e-s-s-s?

Reporter: I'm a reporter from _____(name)_____, the district publication for these ladies. What would you like to tell our readers today about mites?

Mighty Mission Mite: *(enthusiastically – looks at audience)* Keep collecting those mites! Your mites can help spread the Word of God – the Good News of Jesus, our Savior – to the whole world. Reporter: Who can participate?
