Women's Witness and Mercy Asia—\$100,000 [pictured]

Women in Mission realize that mission grants to missionaries in the field bring God's Word to a dying world. Asia is predominately Buddhist, Muslim, and other false religions. Throughout Asia there are 10 women who conduct various mission works through teaching, acts of mercy, and witnessing the Gospel. Some work with their families alongside them, and others, with a team or alone. This grant will help support these women in their unique setting in Asia.

Ministry in Motion—\$58,000

Through the ministry of Trinity Lutheran Church in Mobile, Alabama, modeled after the ministry of Rosa J. Young, Christ-centered education is provided in the community. They serve 200 students from infants through fifth grade, as well as an additional 45 students from four public schools, through chapel, daily prayer, and daily devotions. This mission grant will be used to purchase a handicapped-accessible bus for school children, older adults, neighbors, and church members to participate in church and school ministries.

Touching the Living Word—\$100,000

Lutheran Braille Workers currently produce Bibles and other materials by using zinc plates, Braille presses, specialized paper, covers, and spiral bindings. They have published more than 220,000 volumes during the last 42 months, and the demand keeps increasing. This demand takes its toll on the production equipment, since each page requires separate zinc plates produced by a plate-embossing device. With this mission grant, LBW will be able to purchase a PUMA embossing device capable of creating the necessary number of zinc plates to meet production needs and will also allow the production of more plates in different languages to reach a greater number of people.
