This month we focus on a mission grant selected during the LWML 2013 Convention.

The Northern Illinois District of The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod saw a need to reach out to persons in the area who suffer from developmental disabilities. Voice of Care Ministry to the Developmentally Challenged was formed to reach those not being served by local congregations and residing in secular facilities. This grant will provide needed financial support for equipment being used by volunteers from the area.
