Kansas Holds First District Convention of 2014

Karen Morrison led her first Lutheran Women's Missionary League (LWML) District Convention as President in Wichita, Kansas, on March 28-30, 2014. Under the theme, "On Wings Like Eagles," 362 attendees, including 38 first-timers, gathered for worship, prayer, servant events, and activities drawing them closer to God and each other. business, a Gifts from the Heart ingathering, and a pledge walk.

The Young Woman Representative Committee welcomed 16 young women with special programming. The theme verse "... but those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint" (Isaiah 40:31 NIV), captured the heart of all attending.
