

More Grants Funded as Prayers and Giving Continue



The Lutheran Women's Missionary League (LWML) announces more gifts given to fund the following Mission Grants for the 2013-2015 biennium. Thanks be to God for the faithful prayers and mite giving of His children! Learn more about each grant at www.lwml.org.

Final payment of \$50,000 for Bible Story Books in Sign Language and Written Text. Lutheran Friends of the Deaf are publishing and distributing Bible storybooks to deaf children throughout the world so that they may know the love of Christ. **PAID IN FULL!**

Second payment of \$20,000 for Christ-Centered Tutoring Through Rebecca's Garden of Hope (RGOH). RGOH is a tutoring and mentoring outreach ministry, improving academic grades and church and Sunday school attendance. An additional \$30,000 is still needed to complete this grant.

Partial payment of \$5,000 for Student Scholarships for MOST Ministries Mission Trips. This grant will provide scholarships to fifteen college and university students so they may go on short term mission trips, giving them experiences to inspire future work in the mission field. An additional \$15,000 is still needed to fund this grant.

Second payment of \$5,000 for Support for Lutheran Public Radio. This grant will help allow the director of business operations to devote more time to development, so that the radio and internet show, "Issues, Etc.," can continue to proclaim the Gospel and provide a better understanding of contemporary social issues in a Christian context. An additional \$30,000 remains to be paid to complete this grant.



You may help fund the remaining mission grants of this biennium and meet our national goal of \$1.83 million. Each district also has their own mission grant goal. By God's grace, your mite offerings, along with the contributions of other LWML supporters, will help meet these mission goals.
