PRESIDENT WENDORF KEYNOTE SPEAKER AT LCEF CONFERENCE



Nashville, Tennessee — Janice Wendorf, President of the Lutheran Women's Missionary League, was a keynote speaker at the Lutheran Church Extension Fund (LCEF) Fall Leadership Conference on Sunday, November 21, 2010.

Addressing the more than 650 at the conference, Jan shared, "Women of all ages who have a heart for Jesus are welcome and needed for our shared mission. The LWML is comprised of women — each one unique as an individual, but united with others who rejoice in the gift of faith in Christ."

President Wendorf highlighted the Face of LWML campaign that is designed to encourage everyday women in the pew who represent various cultures, including age, seasons of life, and ethnicity, to tell their story of how the LWML impacts their life.

In 2012 the LWML will mark its 70th anniversary. Jan said, "We can see the amazing work the Lord has done and look ahead with excitement as He reveals what He would have us do in the future."

While attending the conference, Jan participated in the servant event where attendees took time to write cards and letters to members of the Armed Forces. Working with LCMS Armed Forces Ministry, LCEF coordinated the event where more than 1,500 greetings were created to send to deployed troops.
