

KFUO Radio is expanding its Gospel Outreach Ministry with the help of LWML. At the LWML 2019 Convention in Mobile, Alabama, KFUE Radio was awarded a mission grant of \$60,000 to improve its current equipment and acquire the latest technology to help increase their listenership, bringing the Gospel to even more people around the world. This grant was distributed to KFUE in the fall of 2020.

KFUE Radio broadcasts a variety of Christ-centered programming, including Bible studies, daily devotions, sacred music, apologetics, and more. “Our Sunday Morning Worship Service is especially popular simply because it’s a way for the home-bound to join in worship,” states Gary Duncan, Executive Director of KFUE. “The listenership for all of KFUE’s programs has increased greatly since COVID-19 began. People want to hear the Good News of Jesus Christ, now more than ever.”

Currently, KFUE is working on several technology improvements and upgrades to help expand its Gospel broadcasting. Some of these efforts include bringing back the KFUE app for Android

phone users and adding KFUE to the Connected Car Radio. Another exciting effort being made by KFUE is adding Smart Features to Alexa and Amazon Echo devices. The Smart Feature would enable listeners to ask questions while listening to a live program. Those questions would be received by the on-air staff, allowing them to give real-time, on-air answers. KFUE Radio greatly appreciates the support and encouragement of the LWML as we partner together in sharing the Gospel!
