What does “doctrinal review” mean?

A pastoral counselor first looks at it for doctrinal clarity and accuracy. He may make suggestions of changes for the author to consider before sending it to St. Louis for review by a member of the LCMS Doctrinal Review Committee.

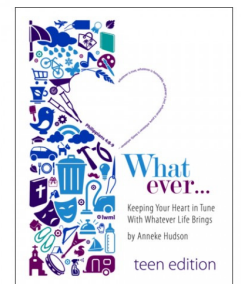
The Doctrinal Review Committee member can return the document to the Counselor with one of five comments on it.

1. Passed as is as it proclaims our doctrine in its truth and purity.
2. Passed but with suggestions on how to make it even better.
3. Revisions are needed and here are some suggestions.
4. Revisions are needed with no suggestions.
5. Failed.

Once it is passed, it is ready to be shared.
