Mailbox Member Program

The LWML has a program to help you intentionally reach the women of your congregation who may not be participating in established LWML group activities. The Mailbox Member Program is designed to connect women monthly to the Word through Bible studies, devotions, and service opportunities available in the LWML and in your local group.



You can adapt this program to fit your setting, so you can engage with the women who:

- Work outside of the home and have schedules that do not allow them to attend LWML activities;
- Are homebound or live in an assisted living or care facility;
- Are unable to attend meetings due to their children's schedules;
- Are recovering from illness or an injury;
- Are unable to attend due to distance;
- Attend a college/university;
- Are missionaries around the world; and
- Want to be a Lutheran Woman in Mission!
