Phil's Friends' team and volunteers provide practical, emotional, and spiritual support through care packages and cards of encouragement. Over a 12-month period close to 6,000 packages and 40,000 Cards of Hope will be sent.

Leader: By showing the cancer patient Christ's unconditional love, it opens the door for Phil's Friends to share with them the true love that comes from a relationship with Jesus.

Leader: One cancer patient said, "I received my care package and first card when I started radiation therapy. It was as if the angels had sent it to me. I remember thinking "how much someone loved me" to send this to me."

Leader: Another patient said, "I was so pleased to receive all the cards and packages. I was so frightened, and your cards gave me courage. I am so much better now. I appreciated everyone who thought about me."
