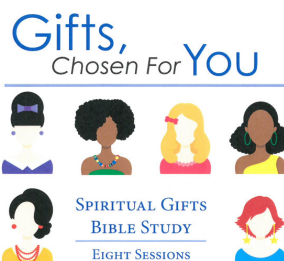

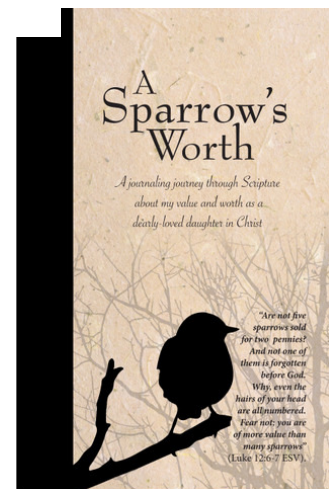


## LOOK What's new at convention?

## Being Intentional In Prayer

## Being Intentional in Prayer ... Getting Started!

**The Penny Prayer** – Write down all of the blessings, people, organizations, for whom you want to pray. Each day as you pray, place a penny in a container for each item on your prayer list. The more you pray, the more pennies that accumulate! Use these pennies as a mites donation, an offering to God, to support a missionary that is close to your heart, or to share a blessing for one of those for whom you pray.



**Start a prayer journal** – Divide it into sections – things you are grateful for, people to pray for, short term requests, long term requests, and prayers answered. The sample template was provided last month.



**Set your alarm clock 15 minutes early** – let your family know that you will be in prayer time and not to interrupt you and spend that extra 15 minutes in prayer.

**Get Mission Prayer Cards from the LWML** – pray for the mission work we support through the LWML and use information prepared by your own LWML district to pray for missions supported within your own district as well.
