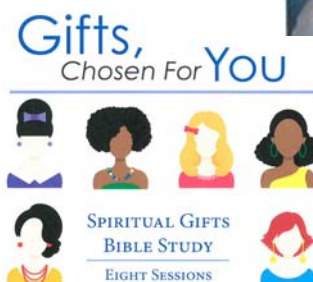

Reach Out to Others by Saron Yohannes

In John 4 Jesus reaches out to the Samaritan woman at the well; one who has been shunned by her community because of her unsavory life history, by the Jews because of her heritage, and by others because of her sex. Time and again, as in this account, Jesus reached out to others: lepers, the lame, foreigners, the mentally ill, tax collectors, and those who were ritually unclean. He knew their need. He felt their pain and sorrow. He ministered to them. He offered them living water.

As we seek to follow Jesus' example in our LWML groups, we need to reflect on who those "others" are in our congregations and communities. Are they young women? Senior citizens? Unwed mothers? Foreign born? Living in poverty? Uneducated? Ensnared by addiction?



As we plan our LWML meetings, programs, studies, and activities let's think about how we can show these "others" that Jesus cares. Jesus did not come to serve Himself and through Him, you and I are equipped and empowered to serve those our Heavenly Father places in our lives. We should not serve ourselves either. Resolve today, and in the coming biennium, to pray about how you can and will use the many, many wonderful LWML resources to build up and serve your "others."
