HALF DAY TOURS

Ethnic Bakeries of Milwaukee / \$89

Learn about the historical perspective of the ethnicities that founded Milwaukee. An excellent opportunity to taste signature cookies, candies, and pastries from four bakeries in Milwaukee! This tour also includes ham sandwiches for an early and light lunch.

Wednesday morning & afternoon, Thursday afternoon. Moderate.

Let's Start Crafting and Have Some Fun / \$105

Crafting activity at the Wisconsin Quilting and Fiber Arts Museum. Open shopping time with sweet treats at three of the Washington Avenue eateries. Includes Cedar Creek Winery Tasting.

Monday morning. Moderate.

Churches & Chocolates / \$102

Fully narrated tour through Milwaukee, long known as the "City of Steeples." During the tour you'll visit three churches, where a guide will share about the history and architecture of Grace Evangelical Lutheran Church, Trinity Lutheran Church, and St. Joan of Arc Chapel on the Marquette University campus. You will visit a local chocolate shop where you'll have the opportunity to taste and shop for treats.

Wednesday morning and afternoon, Thursday morning and afternoon, Monday morning. Moderate.

Harley Davidson Museum / \$118

Tour the Harley Davidson Museum with a guide who will share stories about this unique company and how it historically impacted the city of Milwaukee. Enjoy lunch at the Motor Restaurant located on the Museum campus. Along the way to a tour of the historic Pabst Mansion, we will narrate a city tour focused on Milwaukee's manufacturing history.

Thursday afternoon, Monday afternoon. Moderate.

Milwaukee's Greatest Hits Sightseeing Tour / \$79

Travel through key neighborhoods and attractions of downtown Milwaukee. Your guide will share stories of the neighborhoods originally settled by Italian, Irish, Polish, and German immigrants and point out architectural highlights and cultural hot spots. Stop at the Milwaukee Art Museum to see the iconic white suspension bridge and Burke Brise Soleil, climb to the top of the North Point Lighthouse, and have time to souvenir shop and stroll your way through the historic Pabst Mansion.

Wednesday morning, Thursday morning and afternoon, Monday afternoon. Moderate.

Milwaukee Art Walk / \$48

Tour capacity is 16 guests

With a local artist as your tour guide, the MKE Art Walk begins by sipping a glass of champagne at the Saint Kate Arts Hotel. Then walk along the Milwaukee Riverwalk to see the largest contemporary urban art exhibition in the world known as SculptureMKE. During the walk, the artist will take you to see a selection of art spaces and provide a lesson about the artists featured.

Wednesday afternoon. High.

Lunch on Brady Street / \$85

Tour capacity is 20 guests

Enjoy a progressive lunch on this three-hour walking tour through Brady Street, originally settled by Italian and Polish immigrants. The tour will introduce you to authentic Italian eateries, and new establishments that revitalized this community, to enjoy samples that add up to a meal. All food and beverages are included in the price of the tour.

Wednesday at 11 a.m., Thursday at 11 a.m., Sunday at 1 p.m.. High.

Pedal Thru Milwaukee / \$159

Tour capacity 12 to 16 guests

Spend your afternoon on Milwaukee's favorite bicycle built for 16! On this three-hour tour through Milwaukee's Walker's Point neighborhood, you and your fellow guests power the pedal tavern! You'll stop at three local watering holes for drinks and snacks along the way.

Beer Barons of Milwaukee / \$89

Start with a tour at the Pabst Brewery campus and enjoy a complimentary beverage of choice. Enjoy a narrated city bus tour of Milwaukee focused on the city's original beer barons. Visit the Pabst Mansion and experience an in-depth, guided tour.

Modern Craft Beer Tour / \$96

Tour capacity 28 guests

Tour three of Milwaukee's craft breweries. Samples will be offered at each location.

DAY TRIP OPTIONS

A Day on the North Shore / \$170

This guided walking tour of **Concordia University-Wisconsin (Mequon)** will give insight on what it's like to be a student at this Lutheran university. Then travel north to Wade House for a light lunch, tour of the historic mansion, and a horse drawn carriage ride through the property.

Wednesday, Thursday, Monday. High.

A Day in Oak Park, IL / \$175

Travel to Oak Park, IL, via coach bus for a walking tour of the **Concordia University-Chicago** campus. In the afternoon visit Frank Lloyd Wright's iconic home and studio for a guided tour with an in-depth look into Wright's life and architecture style. Tour includes a light lunch.

Wednesday, Thursday, Monday. High.

Green Bay / \$235

Visit Lambeau Field in Green Bay for their Legendary Tour of the players-tunnel, walk alongside the field, see stadium premium levels and best views of Lambeau Field's south end zone, and tour the press box and visiting team locker room. Explore the Packers Hall of Fame and shop in the Packers Pro Shop. Lunch at Lambeau Field's 1919 Kitchen and Tap.

Wednesday. High.

A Day in Historic Racine and Kenosha / \$107

Visit the headquarters of SC Johnson. This 90-minute tour of the global headquarters of the full SC Johnson campus will include hearing about the legendary partnership between third-generation company leader H.F. Johnson, Jr. and the renowned architect Frank Lloyd Wright. Enjoy shopping time and samples at the Mars Cheese Castle. Enjoy a German lunch at Racine's historic House of Gerard restaurant. Spend the afternoon riding Kenosha's 2-mile streetcar loop to explore the shops and attractions in the historic business district.

Thursday. Moderate.

A Day on the lake in Lake Geneva / \$142

A 2-hour, narrated boat tour of Lake Geneva that will take an in-depth look at some of the area's most unique properties. Enjoy lunch at Lake Geneva's Oakfire Pizza. Spend the afternoon shopping or enjoying the lakefront.

Monday. Moderate.

Travel Back in Time:

A Day at Old World Wisconsin / \$145

Spend the day watching Wisconsin history come alive. You will find buildings that let you self-explore, gardens to wander through, and costumed staff ready to help you get hands-on with history. Travel in time on a self-guided tour from the 1840s to the 1910s, experiencing daily life. Enjoy an outdoor lunch on the Old World Wisconsin property. Although a tram is available, enjoying Old World Wisconsin to its fullest extent involves a considerable amount of walking during the day.

Wednesday, Thursday. Very High.

Progressive Ethnic Meal / \$125

Begin this tour along Lake Michigan before continuing onto Brady Street to visit Peter Sciortino's Bakery for Italian cookies. Travel via your bus to Old World 3rd Street with a narration of Milwaukee's German history. Spend time shopping for cheese, sausage, and spices. Enjoy a family-style meal at Milwaukee's last remaining German, Polish, or Serbian restaurant. Lunch includes a complementary beverage per person. End the meal with custard from Leon's Custard for dessert. Return to Wisconsin Center or convention center at 3 p.m.

Sightseeing Cruise via MKE Boat / \$45 Sunday, June 25

Explore Milwaukee's past and present from our rivers, harbors, and Lake Michigan during a 90-minute narrated sightseeing cruise. Drinks are available for purchase on this tour open to the public. Please note: Guests will have to walk to Old World 3rd Street to board the boat as no transportation is provided.

Edelweiss Cruise / \$96 Thursday, June 22, Tour minimum is 50 guests

Enjoy this 2-hour private scenic cruise down the Milwaukee River. A lunch buffet is included. Non-alcoholic beverages will be available. Ground transportation is available to the boat dock.
