# Celebrating Heart to Heart — Sisters of All Nations and Young Women in Mission



The Lutheran Women's Missionary League (LWML) is celebrating two special programs that share milestone anniversaries this year. At the 2023 LWML Convention in Milwaukee this summer, both the Young Woman Representatives (YWR) as well as Heart to Heart — Sisters of All Nations (H2H) programs will be honored as LWML celebrates with an anniversary tribute honoring the involvement of young women and multicultural women.

In 1973 the first "youth representatives" were invited to attend the LWML Convention in Mobile. Eight women from the Minnesota South District (1), Ohio District (2), North Wisconsin District (2), South Wisconsin District (1) and Minnesota North District (2) accepted the invitation. Other districts did not send a "youth rep" to Mobile mostly because of financial concerns. When the idea was officially adopted for the 1975 LWML Convention in St. Paul 26 districts participated. Special programming was developed for the 45 "youth delegates" who attended that convention. This program continues today as the Young Woman Representatives (YWR) program organized by the Committee on Young Women. While this is not the official anniversary of the YWR program, we are excited to recognize that it began 50 years ago.

The H2H program began when 22 Hispanic and African American women church leaders were invited to a pre-convention seminar at the 2003 LWML Convention in Oklahoma City. For many their attendance at the convention was the first exposure they had to the work of the LWML. Through these twenty years, women from many different ethnic backgrounds have experienced the H2H program. Today the program has expanded to encourage districts to welcome and involve women of varying ethnic backgrounds. To aid them with this work districts send women to attend a 1-day pre-convention training for their role as H2H District Leaders with the focus on developing cross-cultural relationships in all levels of LWML.

All H2H and YWR women are invited to stop by the Reunion table in the registration area of the Wisconsin Center's first-floor lobby to receive a ribbon and instructions on how you can participate in the celebration.

Reunion Receptions will be held on Friday, June 23, at 9 p.m. (check the convention newspaper for the locations). All women who have been involved in these two programs are invited to these receptions to get reacquainted and celebrate the involvement of all our sisters in Christ.
