

off point will be separate from the loading dock. The Mercy Meals packaging area will be expanded, and the number of meals packaged can increase from five million a year to more than ten million a year. A break area for volunteers and an instructional area are also included in the plans. The updated center will be a safer work environment for the all-volunteer staff. Norfolk is just one of twenty-eight Orphan Grain Train warehouse sites across the U.S.

Once the Orphan Grain Train Servant Center is complete, it will serve millions of people both in the United States and around the world, bringing food, clothing, medical supplies and equipment, and educational materials tied with the lifesaving Gospel of Jesus Christ.
