Elizabeth

Mary (the mother of Jesus)

Mary, a young virgin in her teens, was given some life-changing news from God through the angel Gabriel. Read **Luke 1:26-38**. How does she respond?

Read the Christmas account found in Luke 2:1-20 . Wh
In Luke 2:33–35 , Mary received some sobering news from Simeon in the temple. Compare these words with John 19:25–27 .
Read Luke 2:39-42 . What kind of parents were Mary and Joseph?
Faith Talk: How do you think God equipped Mary for her unique role as the mother of the Savior?
Faith Talk: Acts 1:14 indicates Mary was active in the early church. How was she equipped to bolster and
encourage these early believers in Jesus Christ?

Anna

Anna, a prophetess who was considerably older than Mary (and also older than Elizabeth), had an encounter with Jesus and his parents in the temple. Read **Luke 2:36-38**. What is known about Anna (vs. 36-37)?

What did she do after she saw the Christ-child in the temple (v. 38)?	
Faith Talk: How did Anna's 84 years equip her to witness to Mary and all who were at the temple?	
Faith Talk: How have the years of your life equipper	
you to be a witness about the Good News of salvatic	
in Jesus Christ? Who does this equipping? See	
Hebrews 13:20-21.	

Faith Walk:

- 1. Read and meditate on **Luke 1:46-56**. Find various versions of Mary's "Magnificat" in the *Lutheran Service Book* and on the internet.
- 2. Pray to the Lord, asking Him to equip you for a unique task in His kingdom. Ask for His guidance and encouragement to undertake it.

Closing: Pray and sing "Lord of All Hopefulness" (*LSB* 738).
