

THE TWELVE DAYS OF CIRCLE

A Singing Sketch

Some LWML societies have "Circles" which meet monthly. Thirteen women and a pianist are needed for this sketch. The twelve circle members each hold an object or use a designated action for their stanzas as they speak or sing their individual lines. Once the stanza is sung the first time, all members of the sketch and the audience help sing the lines each time they are repeated.

This is sung to the tune of "The Twelve Days of Christmas."

Narrator: On the first day of circle my chairman said to me:

1. God gave us a mission! (hold sign "Lutheran Women's MISSIONary League")

2. Remember your mite box. (hold large mite box)

3. Which office can you serve? (hold gavel, we used large hammer)

4. Here's your new Quarterly. (hold a Quarterly)

5. Let's tie a quilt. (hold a quilt)

6. We're hosting the zone rally. (put stick-on name tags all over the person)

7. It's time for convention. (carry convention bag and/or wear convention shirt)

8. Could you bring a salad? (hold large salad bowl)

9. Let's work on a school kit. (carry a school kit)

10. We're going to the nursing home. (carry tray favors or Bible or similar items)

11. We will pray for you. (fold hands in prayer)

12. Welcome to our circle. (open arms wide, or shake hands with people in the

audience)
