

## How to make an LWML Travel Pillow from an LWML Flag

Finished pillow will be about 9 ½ inches by 12 ½ inches.

Supplies needed:

One LWML Car Flag  
Sewing Machine  
Scissors or Rotary Cutter and Cutting Mat  
Piece of fabric or interfacing for lining approximately 20" x 25'  
Purple thread to match  
Pillow form or poly-fil  
Pins  
Turning tool

1. Remove the flag by slipping off the pole or cutting it off with a scissors or rotary cutter using a cutting mat close to stitching. (recycle the plastic car flag holder)
2. Cut around the flag as close to stitching as possible. The fold and reinforcements that held on to the plastic holder can be cut away.
3. You will now have three (3) large pieces and some scraps from the seams. Discard the scraps from the seams.
4. Discard the middle white fabric.
5. You now have two purple pieces with LWML on each of them.
6. Use a piece of fabric, color of your choice, to line the wrong sides of these two pieces. You could also use an interfacing. (NOTE: If you use a fusible interfacing, first test on a scrap piece of the purple fabric)
7. Baste lining and purple LWML fabric together.
8. Put the right sides of the two purple lined LWML pieces together, secure in place with pins and stitch together with a ¼ inch seam leaving a 10 inch opening on one of the long sides.
9. Trim the corners and turn it right side out and use the turning tool to make the corners sharp.
10. Stuff the pillow with a pillow form or poly-fil and sew the opening shut sewing close to the edges of the fabric.
