#14 BRINGING THE GOSPEL TO THE LOST SHEEP OF ISRAEL \$100,000

One of the unreached people groups to the LCMS are the Jewish people and that is why a part of the mite offerings of the Lutheran Women's Missionary League support the work of The Apple of His Eye Mission Society. This organization does the active work of seed sowing so that God's Spirit can dwell in them by declaring Jesus as their Savior. They perform an effective evangelistic work allowing more than 6 million Jews to have access to the Gospel of the Lord. The funds will be used to bring people to the United States for training, evangelism tools, and materials for outreach, as well as computers for working with database and creative communications.

The Apple of His Eye Mission Society is a pioneer in Christian evangelistic work throughout the Jewish community. Despite the great challenges that exist in the Israeli territory, outside missionaries are scrambling to stay in Israel—many have had visas revoked or not renewed. In order to develop a strategic plan of outreach the mite offerings of the Lutheran Women's Missionary League will financially help to recruit, train, and equip Jewish believers who are Israeli citizens in positions of service and help them to be self-sustaining.
