## **ORIENTATION MEETING**

Thank you for taking the time to attend the orientation days for preschool. We hope we have answered most of your questions and given you sufficient information. #### **CLASS INFORMATION**

Mrs. Sommerer's 5 day class (M-F) begins Wednesday, August 30th and meets 8:45am -11:15am. Tuition is \$230/month.

Mrs. Hunt's 3 day class (MWF) begins Wednesday, August 30th and meets 9:00am - 11:30am. Tuition is \$165/month.

Mrs. Hunt's 2 day class (Tu/Th) begins Thursday, August 31st and meets 9:00am - 11:30am. Tuition is \$130/month.

#### **SCHOLARSHIP MONIES**

There are partial tuition assistance scholarships available for October through May tuition. The monies are from PTO fundraisers and congregational donations. Any student enrolled at Mt. Calvary is eligible—based on need. Application forms are available in the church office and on our website and should be returned to the church secretary by Friday, September 15, 2023. The Board of Education's Scholarship Committee will review all applications and award the money as they see fit. Scholarship monies do not apply toward September tuition. Recipients will be notified prior to October 1st.



## **TUITION**

Tuition is due on the first school day of every month. For September, please take care of tuition the first week of school. Thank you.

\*We are able to take debit/credit card payments. When paying by card: there will be a \$0.45 fee for every transaction and there is a 3% fee if using a credit card. (Fee amounts subject to change). Leah can give you exact fee amounts if you would like the information.

#### **PTO MEETING**

Mt. Calvary Lutheran Preschool PTO will have their first meeting at 11:30am in the gym on Friday, September 8th. Those attending 2 day class (Tues/Thurs) are invited to attend as well. We will be choosing fundraisers and making plans for the year. Please bring your ideas for activities and fundraisers for the year. All family members are welcome. If you are unable to attend, please talk to Leah Koch or any teacher about how you can be involved.

## **COLLECTIBLES/RECYCLING**

We recycle ink cartridges at Staples. We are paid \$2 each for up to 20 cartridges per month. This helps with expenses for school supplies.

#### **CURRICULUM**

The curriculum of Mt. Calvary Lutheran Preschool is based on units. The units may last one or more weeks. Art activities, games, stories, songs and gross motor activities, etc. are usually related to that theme.

Our curriculum also emphasizes self-help and general readiness skills throughout the year. Each student is encouraged to practice, saying audibly their own name in a sentence, parents' names, telephone number and address. We would encourage you to help your child master these important survival skills.
