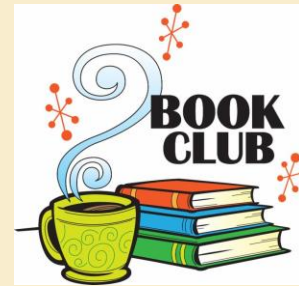

150th ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION AT ST. PAUL LUTHERAN CHURCH
