


#### Land Purchased In 1960

A search for suitable land was elimaxed in October 1960 when the present site of 5 acres was purchased. Plans for the structure were approved in April 1962 and a groundbreaking ceremony was held in August 1962.

In keeping with the rugged beauty of the lake and trees nearby, the chancel wall on the west side makes use of the texture of split-faced concrete block and rises 66 feet above grade. The nave will seat 210 with provisions for 20 in the choir loft. The south wall of the nave is 40 feet high on the interior and is constructed of redwood and glass.

The interior furnishings are of cak in keeping with the wood beams left exposed. The lighting fixtures were built by members of the congregation translucent acrylic shades.
