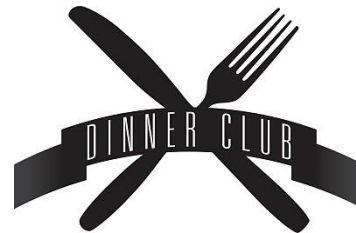


CELEBRATE LIFE!

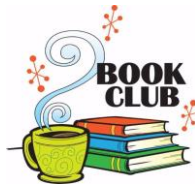
