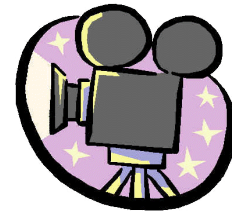
### FEBRUARY FAMILY FELLOWSHIP OPPORTUNITY

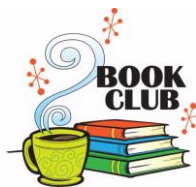
