

In early March I was not feeling well so my son Christopher [a nurse] took me to Bethesda North Hospital where doctors carefully checked me and then removed my infected gall bladder. Unfortunately, a lot of infectious matter remained in my abdomen, so I needed extended treatment with antibiotics. Around the first of April I was transferred to The Lodge Rehabilitation Center for more antibiotic treatment. After that ended, I was sent to the Lodge residential facility for six months of assisted living care. On Monday, October 30, my son Christopher brought me home.
