CALL COMMITTEE

The Voters Assembly has approved the Leadership Board's proposal to begin the call process in preparation for Pastor Stuckwisch's retirement. What does that mean? It means that we will start the steps required by Synod that a congregation must go through in order to call a Pastor.

The first step is to establish a Call Committee. 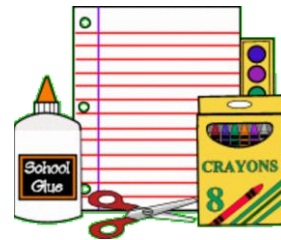

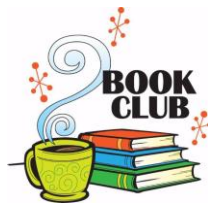
