How can we do these things? Our quilters are doing them. How can a quilt accomplish all that? Begin with using a love of sewing to show your talent and creativity for the benefit of another person. It is indeed gratifying. Our Messiah ladies' quilts go to the LIC annual quilt auction to raise funds for their spiritual outreach.

However, many church groups work on projects other than and including quilts. In 2022, there were 220,317 quilts; 1,650 blankets; 90,860 school kits; 8,280 personal care kits; and 31,950 masks. That's a lot of faith in action, faith through service, and making the world a better place through service. There are many foreign locations where these things are distributed, 19 countries, and now add Turkey and Ukraine.

Minnesota donations go to Burkino Faso, Djibouti, Dominican Republic, Guatemala, Haiti, Niger, Peru, Sierra Leone and Tanzania.

So what can a quilt do? When added to contributions of others, it can have huge impact when given to someone in despair.
