FROM THE PRESIDENT, HARRY EDMON

Messiah is looking for a Music Director starting in September 2023. The Music Director is responsible for directing the Choir and Instrumental Ensemble. Duties include selection of music subject to approval of the Pastor, conducting rehearsals for each group during the week in the evening and prior to services, and directing in the special music time during services. Most services are Sunday morning, but there are additional services during Advent, Christmas, and Lent. Typical week is 5-7 hours plus prep time. Additionally, there has been some uncertainty about how long articles will run in the bulletin. Bulletin articles will now run a maximum of two weeks unless the person submitting the article asks for a longer time, or it is written with an end-date in the announcement.

FROM THE TREASURER

Below is the 2023 Financial Summary through March:

- 2023 Spending Guide (SG) prorated through March: \$134,589
- 2023 Actual Expenses through March: \$130,885 (3% below SG), including funds set
- aside for future use: \$7,500
- 2023 Actual Offerings/Income through March: \$97,822 (27% below SG)

The operating result through the first quarter ending in March is a deficit of (\$33,063). Total Offerings are 5.65% below this same period last year.

We sing, usually, the 2nd and 4th Sundays, sometimes adding an additional Sunday, plus Christmas Eve and Day, a few Lenten Wednesdays, Maundy Thursday, and Easter. When possible important additional Sundays are added. Come join us. It's good for the choir, good for the church, and good for you!
