One person responded knowing that the text was fake and the follow-up text asks the person to buy gift cards that will be given to shut-ins. Pastor and no one else at church would ever ask anyone to buy gift cards via email or text. The church has an Assistance Fund that Pastor can use to help those in need.

Please be aware that criminals will send fake emails and texts claiming to come from Pastor. If you ever have a question whether a message actually came from Pastor please feel free to call or text him at his number in the directory. You can also call the office or Harry Edmon.

FROM THE TREASURER

Below is the 2023 Financial Summary through April:

• 2023 Spending Guide (SG) - prorated through April: \$179,452

- 2023 Actual Expenses through April: \$165,935 (8% below SG), including funds set aside for future use: \$10,000
- 2023 Actual Offerings/Income through April: \$187,723 (5% above SG)

The operating result through the four months ending in April is a surplus of \$21,788. Please remember in your prayers to thank the Lord for Messiah's blessings and pray for His continued gifts to sustain us in the year to come.
