Below is the 2023 Financial Summary through May:

- 2023 Spending Guide (SG) prorated through May: \$224,315
- 2023 Actual Expenses through May: \$200,290 (11% below SG), including funds set aside for future use: \$12,500
- 2023 Actual Offerings/Income through May: \$229,497 (2% above SG)

OUR AMAZING CHOIR— MARTHA CHANNON

Your adept, flexible, and willing choir sang an amazing 30 anthems in 2022 & 2023, with only an hour of practice weekly! They sang the usual Sundays, plus Reformation, Thanksgiving, 2 Advent Wednesdays, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, Transfiguration, Ash Wednesday, 2 Lenten Wednesdays, Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Easter, Ascension, and Pentecost. The Ensemble joined us Easter and the 75th Anniversary.

The music was from several periods and composers. One, William Billings, is from the American Revolution era, He rode Paul Revere's horse and wrote the original American anthem. Two anthems are from a style called "Shape Note." Pastor chooses these hymns often, but in our hymnal they are written in traditional notation instead of the original Shape Note. Included were Baroque composers: Handel, Vivaldi, J.S. Bach; Micahel Praetorius wrote "Psallite," sung at Christmas in Latin and Middle German. The words are:

Psallite unigenito Christo, Dei Filio, Psallite Redemptori, Domino, puerulo jacenti in praesepio. Ein kleines Kindelein liegt in dem Krippelein. Alle lieben Engelein dienen dem Kindelein und singen ihm fein.

Remember to thank our choir members when you see them. Tell them, "Job well done!"
