Dear brothers and sisters,

Advent, which in Latin means "coming," is a joyous season with some of my favorite hymns: O Come O Come Emmanuel, The King Shall Come When Morning Dawns, and Savior of the Nations Come. It is a time to rejoice because our Lord <a href="mailto:came">came</a> into the world for our salvation 2023 years ago, still <a href="comes">comes</a> today in Word and Sacrament, and <a href="will comes">will comes</a> visibly on the Last Day to make all things new. The Lord's advents are always good!

Advent is also a time of repentance. If Christ is coming to take away sins, then it is a perfect time to confess sins. And if we confess our sins, God is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. Repentance is a way of life for Christians; we repent every day. However, seasons like Advent and Lent focus on the topic, highlight the importance, and remind those of us who have wandered to return to the Lord our God.

For us northern hemisphere Christians, there's the additional experience of ever-growing darkness at this time of the year. The darkness makes us crave the light, just as the evil in the world makes us crave the righteousness of Him, who is Light! So, we'll gather during Advent to sing, "Jesus Christ is the Light of the world, the Light no darkness can overcome!"

Last year for Advent, we studied Commandments 1-3. For Lent, we studied Commandments 4-10. This year for Advent, we'll continue our journey through the catechism by studying the articles of the Apostles' Creed. Come on Wednesdays December 6<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup>, and 20<sup>th</sup> for an excellent meal and to celebrate the season.
