From the Desk of Pastor Elliott

Dear brothers and sisters,

We all have so much to be thankful for! It is important that we take time to remember all that God has done for us. When counting our blessings, we can divide them into three categories, corresponding to the three articles ("parts") of the Apostles' Creed.

First, God gives us what we need to support this body and life. Therefore, every breath we take, every beat of our hearts, and even our abilities to think and to feel are all "First Article Gifts," lovingly provided by our Creator. Likewise, food and clothing are gifts. Our work and leisure are gifts. This country is a gift, and all of our relationships—family, friends, coworkers, neighbors—are all granted to us from the tender heart of our dear Heavenly Father.

Second, Jesus Christ is the ultimate gift! "For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son!" And if the Father "did not spare His own Son, but gave Him up for us all, how will He not also with Him graciously give us all things?" Indeed, on the cross, Jesus gave of Himself, pouring out all His precious blood to blot out our transgressions that we might be saved eternally through Him.

Third and finally, we receive the gifts of the Holy Spirit: "the holy Christian church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting." Whereas First Article Gifts have to do with secular things (things of "this age"), Third Article Gifts are the gifts of the age to come, even though we already enjoy them now. These gifts are particular to Christians. To this category belongs the gifts of faith and all which flows from faith.

So, this Thanksgiving make sure that you thank God for ALL the gifts He gives. Thank Him for the First Article Gifts, as even some pagans do. Thank Him for the Second Article Gift—the gift of Jesus! And thank Him for the gift of faith, for it is only through faith that we take hold of Christ and receive the fullness of God's blessings. To God alone be thanks and praise, now and forever. Amen!

FROM THE TREASURER

Below is the 2023 Financial Summary through September:

- 2023 Spending Guide (SG) prorated through September: \$403,768
- 2023 Actual Expenses through September: \$387,847 (4% below SG), including funds set aside for future use: \$22,500
- 2023 Actual Offerings/Income through September: \$387,994 (4% below SG)

The operating result through the nine months ending in September is a surplus of \$147. Please remember in your prayers to thank the Lord for Messiah's blessings and pray for His continued gifts to sustain us in the year to come.
