From the Desk of Pastor Elliott

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

It is such a joy to be your pastor! It is also such a joy to raise my family amongst you all. My family is supremely happy to be here in Seattle. I also think the congregation is doing well. We seem to be growing in faith and love. Attendance is up, which is nice to see. Even better, I see the work of the Holy Spirit in so many. Things are good! "A little too good..." I kid! However, I do believe that we all need to be on our guard against the schemes of the devil. If God is at work amongst us, the devil will not be far away. Satan will try to destroy harmony between church members by creating factions. He'll seek to rob us of mutual forgiveness and brotherly affection. Satan will seek either to make us self-righteous—where we compare ourselves to each other with a sense of superiority—or if that doesn't work, he'll make us lawless and accepting of sinful lifestyles. He's a master of a thousand arts, and our only protection is Jesus.

Therefore, we all need to abide in Jesus, which means to abide in God's Word. The Word is our only hope. Church, Bible Class, home devotions, the singing of hymns, and Christian conversation are all necessary so that God's Word can permeate all our thinking and activities. Below is the Financial Summary through January:

- 2024 Spending Guide (SG) prorated through January: \$43,454
- 2024 Actual Expenses through January: \$36,279 (17% below SG), including funds set aside for future use: \$3,000
- 2024 Actual Offerings/Income through January: \$56,303 (30% above SG)


