STUDENT AID POLICIES

- 1. Aid is available to young people preparing for full-time church work at any of our Synodical schools. Application is on a Yearly Basis. The student must carry a C average to remain eligible.
- 2. Application for Student Aid must be made annually by May 15. Application forms may be obtained from your Student Aid Conference Chairman, the Student Aid Officer of the school you plan to attend, or downloaded from the LCMS website (https://cusapps.cus.edu/cusapps/f?p=141:4:0::NO:4::). It will be to your advantage to obtain the form from your school's Student Aid Officer. After the form is completed, it must be returned to your Student Aid Officer. They will submit the completed form to the District.
