A Different kind of “Trust” Fund

Should you read Psalm 115:9-11 (and please do!) you will find this one word repeated three times. The word is “trust.” You will also find this phrase following the word “trust” three times: “He is their help and their shield.”

Our heavenly Father is a different kind of “trust fund”, isn’t He! Normally a trust fund is something we set up using our resources. In this case, the trust fund is set up using His resources!

“He is their help and their shield.” As you seek to live for Him this day, you can draw on Him. Don’t draw on your resources. Draw on His!

He is your help. He will give you what is necessary for you to live for Him this day. You have His Word on it. Trust Him!

He is your shield. He will guard and protect you from whatever may be lined up against you so as to prevent you from living for Him this day. You have His Word on it. Trust Him!

Trust Him. Trust Him. Trust Him. Three times it is stated. Three times you and I are invited. Three times, as a point of emphasis. Three times, to make the point that He is absolutely and completely reliable. Three times, to mark that this is a holy promise, a promise of His grace, a sure and certain promise.

Draw on His promise to empower you to live for Him today by spending some of the minutes of this day in His Word. Draw on His promise to be your help and your shield by turning to Him frequently in prayer as this day unfolds.

Prayer: Heavenly Father, at Your invitation and by Your promise, may I trust in You this day so that I may live this day for You. In Jesus’ name. Amen.
