#1 From the sermon and what you know, why might a courtroom be a difficult place to be for some people? How might it make them feel?

#2 Based on the sermon, who were the people in power during Jesus' time? Who are a few examples of people who are in power today? When and how can having power go wrong?

#3 Using the sermon and your own knowledge, how does jealousy start in a person? What can happen as a result of jealousy, as we see in what happened to Jesus?

#4 Along with listening to the sermon, read through the lyrics of Hymn #430 “My Song is Love Unknown,” especially verses 4 and 5. Why might we object to the idea of Jesus being found guilty and being punished?

#5 What mistake did those who wanted to get rid of Jesus make? What did they not know about Him and God’s plan?
