Each Wednesday during the season of Lent, we will focus on a different aspect of what Jesus did for us as He carried out His saving work. Please answer these questions completely and turn in your work to the pastors each week.

#1 What is your definition of God's will? Why might some people not like the idea of it? Nevertheless, how is God's will good, especially when it is about Jesus?

#2 Based on the sermon and the readings, how does Isaiah 53:10 talk about what Jesus felt while He was in the Garden of Gethsemane? Why did Jesus feel the way that He did at that point?

#3 Along with listening to the sermon, read through the lyrics of Hymn #420 "Christ the Life of All the Living", especially verse 3. How does this hymn help us understand how Jesus felt when His disciples kept falling asleep as He was praying?

#4 Based on the sermon and the reading from Hebrews, what makes Jesus' sacrifice infinitely better than any previous sacrifices of bulls or goats? What do God's people no longer need to keep doing?

#5 When Isaiah 53:10 talks about the Messiah's offspring, what does that mean? How are we a part of this?
